

REMOTE PRODUCTION (AT-HOME/REMI/HRP)

A typical remote production solution offers an operationally flexible, modern and durable workflow that reduces onsite costs. Small, purposebuilt mobile units can be used at the venue, with only limited hardware and engineering support being required onsite. Video switching, audio mixing, graphics, replays and show production can all be done 'at home' at the broadcast center.

This means fewer crew members need to travel to the event, and additional assets can be called on at the broadcast center, such as telestrators and advanced graphics tools. By using a central control room, multiple events can be produced on the same day, rather than having to tie up valuable resources at just one location.
